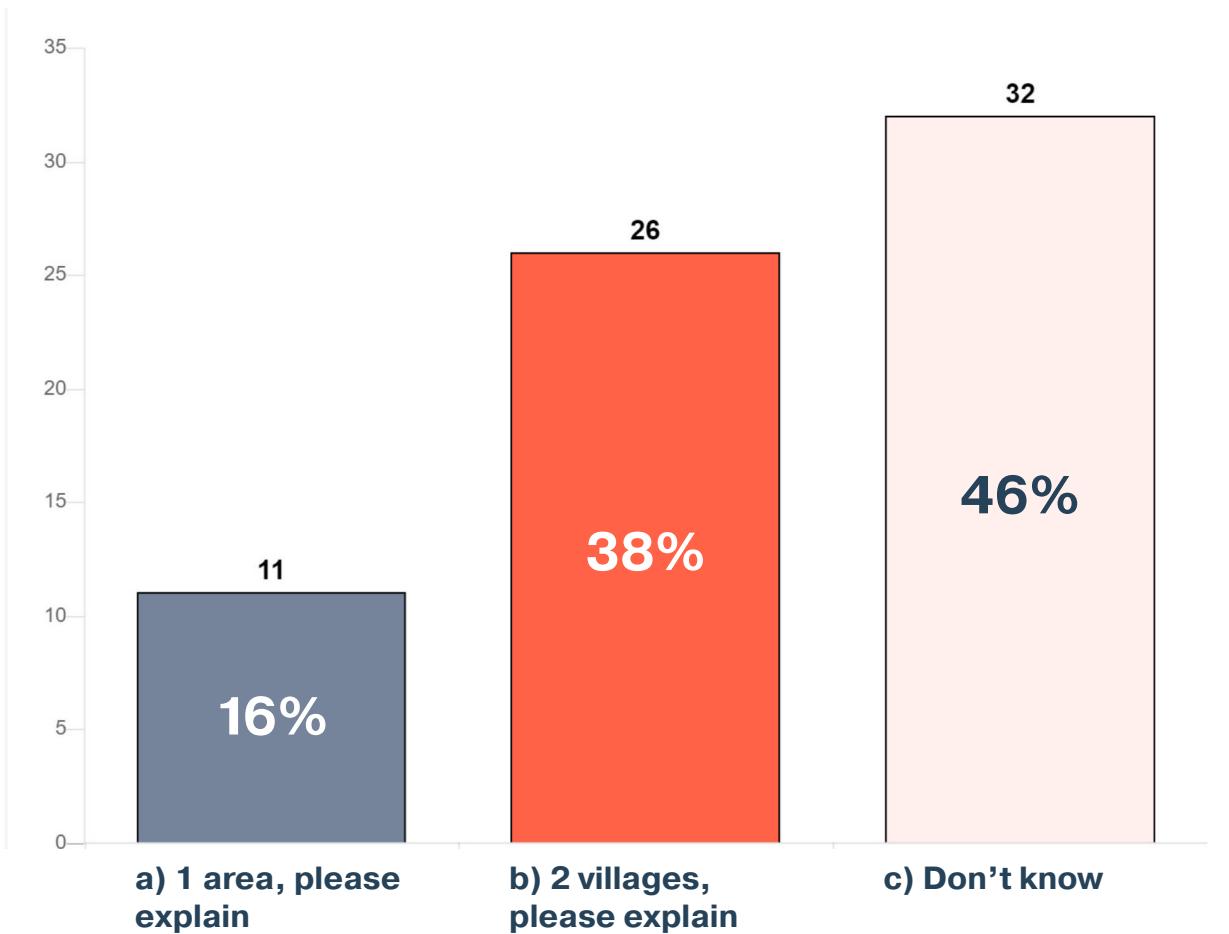

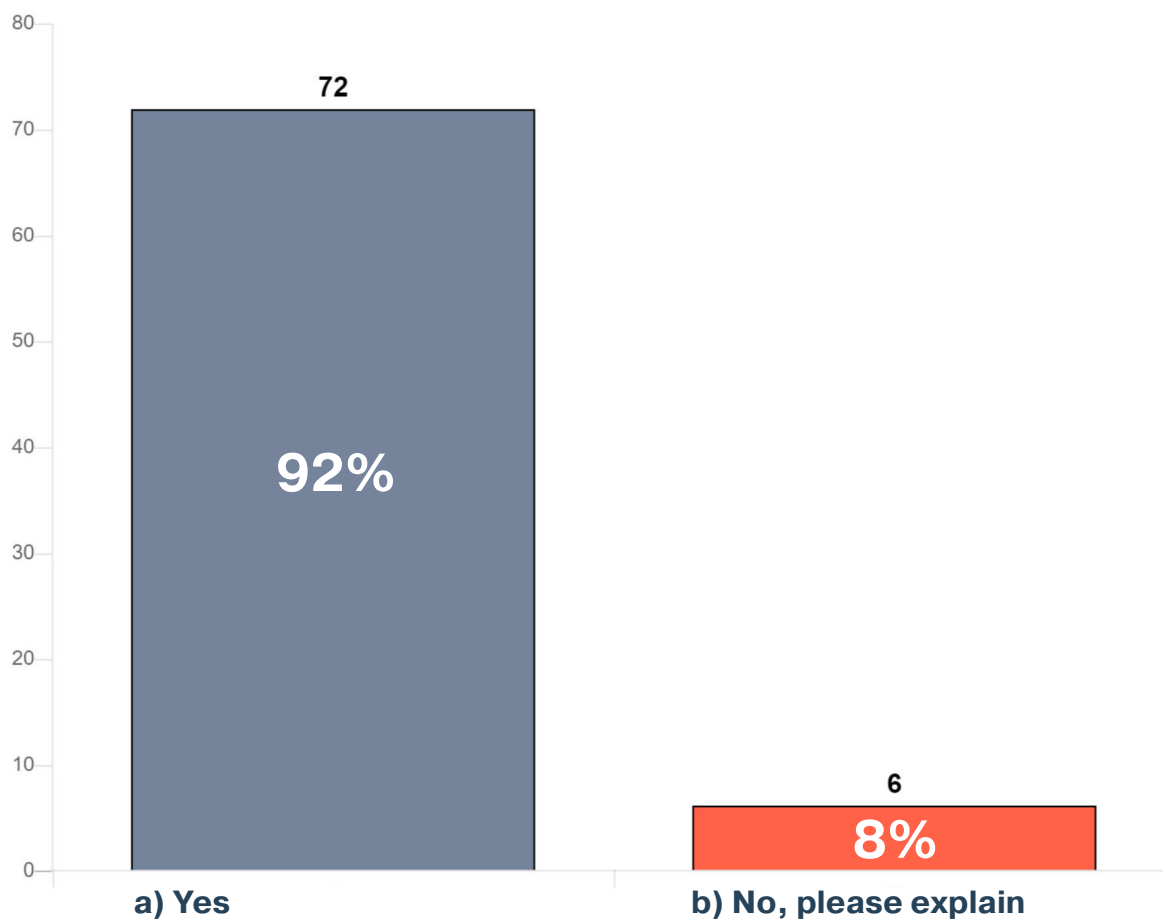
As we do not reside in either village we feel it is a matter for the residents to decide.

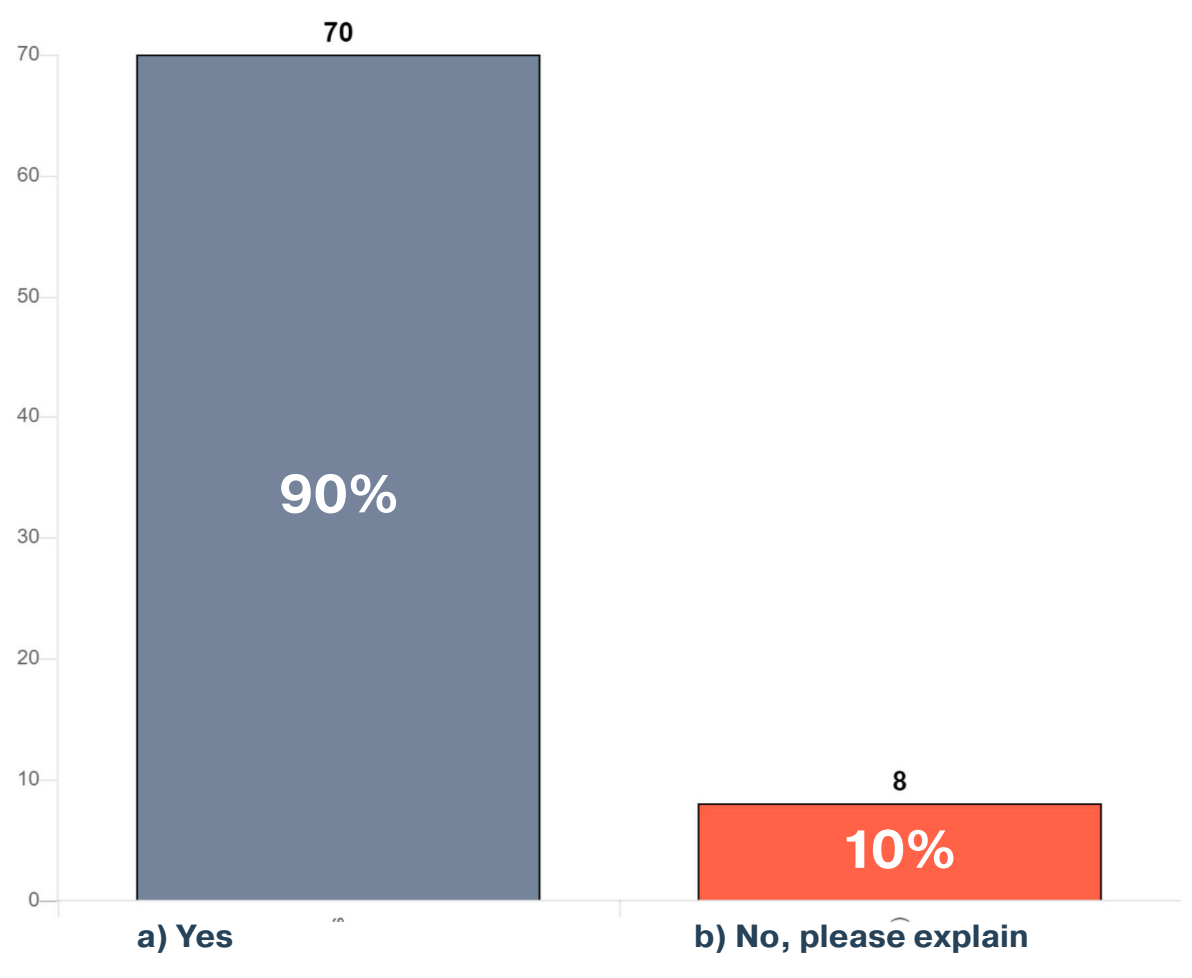
Comment:

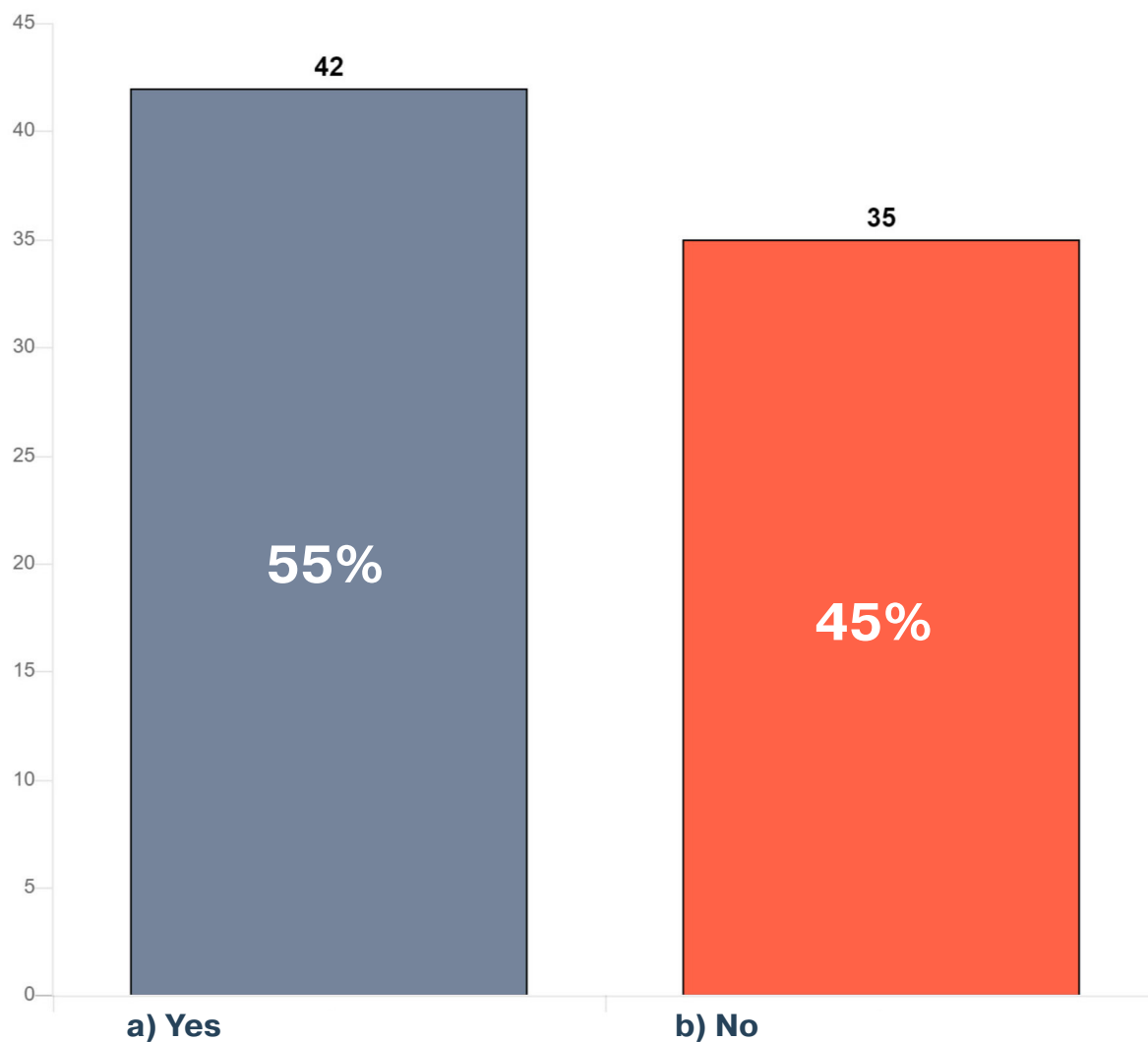

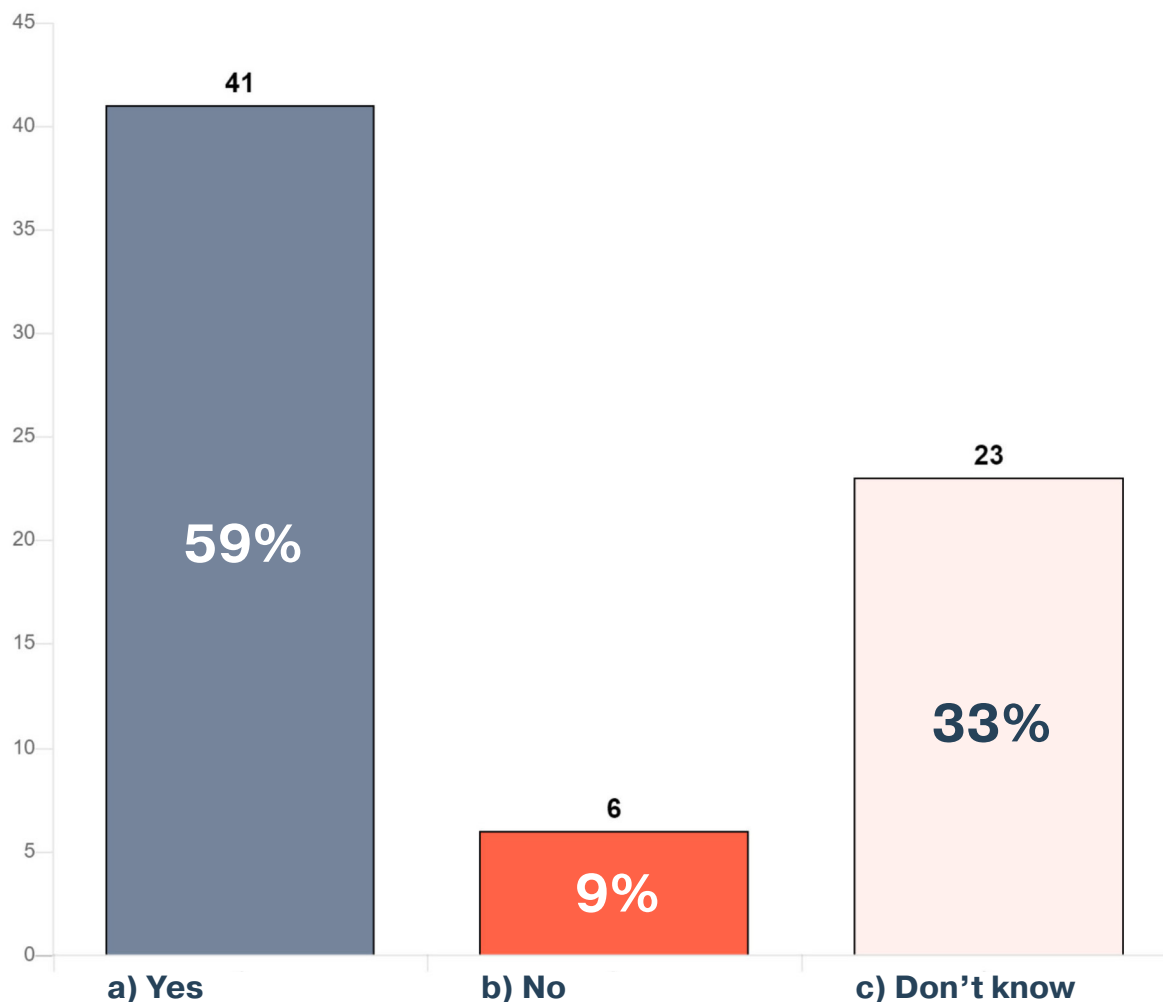

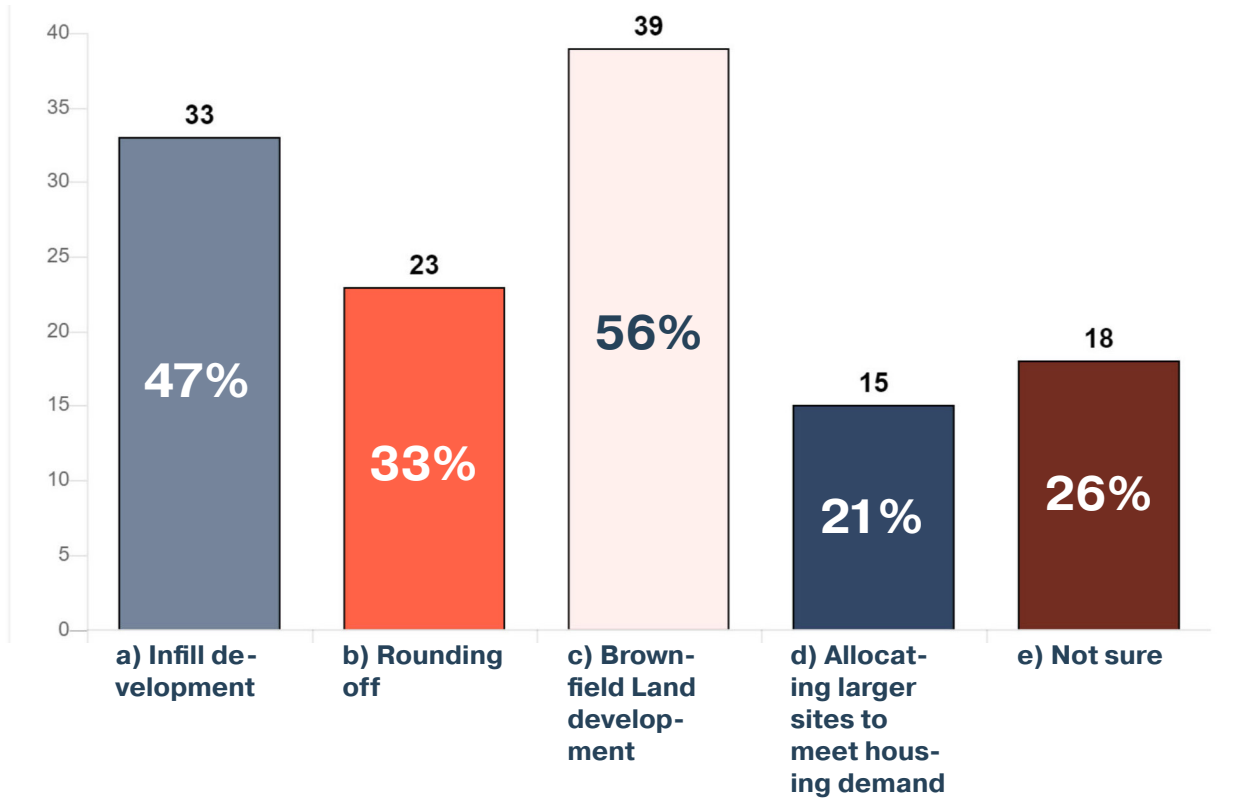
